2023 EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS & OPERATIONS LEVY

The current E, P, & O levy is set to expire at the end of the 2022 tax year. Levy funds enable the District to support educational programs and operations, including teaching, school supplies, technology, athletics, building maintenance, transportation, and other educational needs.

GET THE FACTS, CAST AN INFORMED VOTE

THIS IS NOT A NEW TAX

The February 14, 2023 measure is a **reinstatement** levy and is not a new tax. Levies typically run on a 4-year cycle renewed through voter-approved ballot measures.

LEVIES ARE FOR LEARNING

Levies support areas directly tied to student learning, achievement, health and safety, sports, and school activities.

LOWER TAX RATE

The proposed levy is approximately \$1.67 per thousand of an assessed home value and is 68 cents less per thousand than the expiring measure.

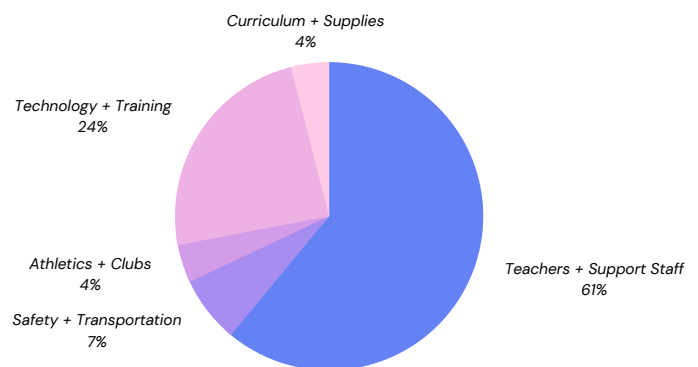

PROPOSITION NO. 1

PROPOSITION NO. 1 MARYSVILLE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 25 REINSTATEMENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS LEVY

The Board of Directors of Marysville School District No. 25 adopted Resolution No. 2023-02 concerning a reinstatement levy for educational funding. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following taxes to fund vital educational programs and operations that are not funded by the state and to replace an expired levy on taxable property within the District.

Collection Years	Estimated Levy Rate/\$1,000 Assessed Value*
2024	\$1.67
2025	\$1.67
2026	\$1.67
2027	\$1.67

*The \$1.67 rate/\$1,000 is an estimate that may slightly reduce or increase over the 4-year period.

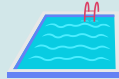
