WHEREAS, the Arlington LGBTQIA+ community has asked for support to ensure the safety of their community and attendees at their upcoming Arlington Pride events, and

WHEREAS, we all strive to create a Snohomish County that stands as a shining example of equality and inclusivity, and

WHEREAS, the LGBTQIA+ community is a valuable part of our broader Snohomish County community and Everett residents will be attending the upcoming Arlington Pride events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EVERETT CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS AND THE MAYOR OF EVERETT:
